

Eliza Cantrell is just such a bride-to-be, and is on her way by train to meet her intended husband when the train is robbed. A group of men come through the carriages and demand money, jewelry and anything of value from the passengers. Eliza has her inheritance with her as a start in her new life, and she tries to hide it from the robbers, but is not successful, and is injured in the process.

When they train finally arrives in Salt Flatts, Eliza has no money, is seriously hurt, and her future husband is not even in town.

This is an interesting story that takes place in a time long past. I thoroughly enjoyed it.
