I, Saul by Jerry Jenkins

This is a very interesting book, which flips back and forward between Paul, the apostle, awaiting death in jail in seriously dire conditions, and an up-to-date trio of friends, who have heard of an old manuscript that could be the find of the century.

2000 years ago - Paul – now an old man – struggles with being in a cold, damp, totally dark jail – he is visited by the Apostle John – who hates to see Paul in these circumstances and tries his best to visit often, make friends with Paul's guard so he can bring some food for him, and try to help him finish his journals.

Saul – who is starting out on his journey as a young boy, hoping to be accepted into college to train as a Pharisee.

Modern day – Three friends are told of an old set of scrolls that have been found and could be worth a lot of money if they can be recovered and sold. Corruption knows no bounds in trying to get hold of any information about these scripts – where they are right now, and how do we get them into our possession?

A well-written fascinating tale that spans 2000 years, that has everything that is needed to make it interesting, scary, heart warming and heart wrenching all at the same time. I hope you enjoy reading this epic tale as much as I did.
