

April 2: Since the beginning of the war in Ukraine, pastors and church workers of the Reformed Church in Transcarpathia, Western Ukraine, have been serving tirelessly, providing spiritual support to those who remained and warmly welcoming refugees and internally displaced people from Eastern and Central Ukraine. Recognizing the dedication and work of these faithful servants, the Reformed Church in Hungary established a solidarity fund and invited partner churches to join in providing encouragement and financial support. The PCC, through Presbyterians Sharing, along with the First Hungarian Presbyterian Church in East Toronto, Ontario, responded by contributing to the fund, which aims to support 100 pastors and church staff in Transcarpathia with a monthly financial supplement of \$360 CAD.

## **Report from Session**

At a Special Session Meeting on Tuesday March 28th the following motions were approved:

- 1. That a congregational meeting be called for Sunday April 16th to consider the call to the candidate preaching for the call.
- 2. It was further moved that the Sunday, April 16th service would not be livestreamed, and a previous service shown online instead.

With regard to the latest COVID-19 guidelines:

3. That Chalmers would follow the Current Guidelines from the Middlesex-London Health Unit concerning COVID-19:

#### SELF-ISOLATION FOR COVID-19 OR FLU SYMPTOMS

#### STAY HOME

If you have symptoms of COVID-19 or the flu, stay home and self-isolate.

# CONSIDER GOING OUT/CONSIDER LEAVING SELF-ISOLATION

- If your symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours if you had nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea).
- If you no longer have a fever.
- If you have not developed additional symptoms.

RETURN TO PUBLIC SETTINGS For the remainder of the 10 days that began when your symptoms started:

- Wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings.
- Avoid non-essential activities where you need to take off your mask (for example, dining out).
- Avoid non-essential visits with anyone who is immunocompromised or may be at higher risk of illness (e.g. seniors).
- Avoid non-essential visits to highest risk settings in the community such as hospitals and longterm care homes.
