June 28: Keeping Connected in Nepal

When Dr. Nicholas and Becky Bauman left Canada in 2017 for two years in Nepal, they were reviving direct connections with people after 20 years. The partnership between The Presbyterian Church in Canada and the United Mission to Nepal began in 1974, and the last mission internship was in 2000. God's mission in the world includes people who share their professional skills while learning about life and faith from co-workers and neighbours. The motto of Tansen Mission Hospital is "We Serve, God Heals." Nepal is very poor, and Becky soon became involved in Tansen's New Life Psychiatric Rehabilitation Centre, which cares for abandoned people with mental health issues. In January 2020, Becky and two of her children returned to Tansen to celebrate the Prayer Dedication of the new Centre, which receives support from Presbyterians Sharing. Although Becky lives in Canada, her deep commitment and partnership will continue. Praise God!

This book takes place in the late 1800's and lets us see a side of life at that time that we really can't understand. Hunter Scott is a Texas Ranger who has been sent to Chicago to provide security at the World Fair – a six month extravaganza that aims at showing off the opportunities and skills of people of importance. Dr Billy Jack Tate is a lady doctor who has been invited to lead a seminar, and help in the local hospital. They meet when Dr Tate is refused admission to the seminar that she has been invited to – and no-one will believe that she is really a doctor. As she finds another way into the seminar, she makes a rather ungainly entrance through a window only to find Hunter waiting to evict her! The other side of the tale shows the abject poverty of the masses and just how difficult it is to even make ends meet. Billy and Hunter get involved in trying to make life a little easier for those people who live with no hope. COVID-19 UPDATE: The Ontario government has further extended most of the emergency orders to July 15 to provide the province with the additional time, flexibility and necessary tools to safely and gradually allow more places to re-open, while continuing to support front-line health care providers.
