### From the Editor

My daughter is obsessed with dinosaurs. We're not talking about the normal level of obsession that every child seems to go through at some point when they learn that dinosaurs once roamed the earth. No, Torry eats, sleeps, dreams about, sings about, plays with, watches, learns about, and talks about nothing but dinosaurs. She is on a whole other level of obsession that causes me to have to study just to be able to keep up with her. A conversation last week went something like this (keep in mind that she's just four):

Torry: Mummy, guess what kind of dinosaur I'm thinking about.

Me: OK, give me some clues. Torry: It's a bipedal herbivore with long arms and feathers.

Me: Hmm, I can't think of any bipedal herbivores. Are you sure?

Torry: Oops, you're right. It's not a herbivore, it's an omnivore 'cause it eats fish as well as plants.

Me: Well, is it an ornithomimus?

Torry: No mummy, ornithomimus didn't have feathers. It's a velociraptor!

As interesting as that conversation was, we had an even better one in the car yesterday. As, I'm sure, all children are, Torry's very curious about why there are no dinosaurs now. We have read all the different theories and she has her own opinion on which theory is the best, but she wants to know for sure. So yesterday we were driving in the car, listening to Bill Gaither (Southern Gospel) and I was singing along with a song about someday going to heaven. Torry interrupted me and asked what the song was about. I explained and she was quiet for a few minutes (rare!). Suddenly, she burst out, "Mummy, you know what I'm going to do? When we go to heaven, I'm going to ask Jesus what killed the dinosaurs 'cause he'll know for sure!" Sounds like a good idea to me. We went back to singing until a few minutes later she asked what's going to live on the earth after all the humans have died. When I told her I didn't know, she had a perfect solution. "When we get to heaven, mummy, we can go talk to Jesus and he can answer all my questions that you don't know the answers for." I hope lesus has a lot of free time!

Sometimes our jobs as parents can seem overwhelming. There are so many things for our children to learn and we want to teach them everything we can to make them safe and successful and healthy and faithful and helpful and kind. But we have so many opportunities to teach them when we're not even trying. Conversations on the walk to school or when driving in the car or eating dinner together are sometimes much more powerful than the lectures we expect to give to cover the "big" issues. And many times I find that I learn as much from chatting with Torry as she learns from me, and not just about dinosaurs!



Addendum: A couple of days after writing this article, Torry & I were chatting again and we passed some vandalism. She asked me why people would do that and I admitted that I don't know why people do mean things. "Well, I guess they just haven't let Jesus into their hearts." Through the eyes of a child, eh?
