Letter from the Editor by Lizz Thibodeau

Youth Ministry is an exciting ministry to be involved in. There is always something going on, you get to spend time with teenagers and young adults, and you get to participate in fun activities like Turkey Treks and Canada Youth. But there's a lot more to youth ministry than just providing a fun place for youth to connect with the church. At the very root, our goal is not really for the youth to connect with the church, but for the youth to connect with Jesus and to choose to accept Him as their saviour. All of the goofy things that we do are simply ways to provide opportunities for the youth to feel comfortable at church, in the hopes that the more often they come to church, whether for worship or activities or youth events, the more times they'll hear about Jesus and God's love and the more likely they are to make that choice.

In December, Chalmers has joined with several other churches in the Presbytery of London to offer a joint Confirmation class or Communicants' class; a class for those young people who are interested in joining the church and professing their faith. This is an exciting step in the faith journey of these youth and young adults.

The classes will be offered on Sunday afternoons from 1pm until 2:30pm right here at Chalmers (the other churches involved felt that we were the most centrally located). The classes will be every other Sunday starting December 1st and continuing until Easter.

For some youth, joining the church is an obvious "next step". It's something that they've been anticipating and looking forward to for several years. It feels like a rite of passage for them—not just a step on their faith journey, but also a step towards adulthood. For other youth, I've found myself trying to explain why they might want to take this step. See, I was one of that first group of youth, the ones who just knew they would one day stand at the front of the church and profess their faith. There was no "why" to it for me. But as a youth leader, I need to think about this more deeply. Why do we do this? After some thought, I decided it's kind of like getting married. Why do we do that? Plenty of people don't bother with the formality and just move in together. What's the importance of the ceremony? Well, it's an opportunity for two people who love each other to stand in front of those closest to them and declare that love and their desire to be together. They declare before God that this is their choice. Isn't confirmation basically the same thing? It's an opportunity to stand before your faith community and declare your love for Jesus, your desire to follow Him and the fact that this is your choice alone, not that of your parents (as was your Baptism).

What a thing to celebrate! I hope that by April, we will have several youth who have made this choice. And I think we should do something really goofy and throw a party to celebrate, but maybe that's just youth ministry getting to me!

Rodger Nishioka & John Roberto




