Cyclone Freddy-one of October 29: the most powerful storms ever recorded in the southern hemisphere-made landfall in Malawi in March 2023. Thousands in Malawi were left homeless, and with severe crop losses, over 345,000 people were affected by the heavy rains, floods and landslides. Through its partners, PWS&D responded to this devastating disaster by providing maize flour and soya to enable families to meet their immediate food requirements. Additionally, because of critical food insecurity due to droughts and floods in the area, PWS&D implemented three-month food а assistance project for 2,500 households. This project provided food assistance in the form of cash transfers, as well as seeds to produce high-value crops.

#### From the Trustees:

With the sale of the manse in September, Chalmers now has a significant sum of money to invest for future use. The trustees, in consultation with our treasurer and several financial advisors. proposed to the congregation to invest this money in the Presbyterian Church in Canada's Consolidated Portfolio. This portfolio is well diversified, offering us a safe and profitable investment. It is well managed by a team of financial experts. Because the fund is managed through PCC, we can also be confident that the portfolio is well-aligned with the church's vision and values. Because this portfolio is so strong, the trustees also proposed investing the Memorial Fund in conjunction with the Manse Fund. Both funds will continue to be monitored by the Trustees. This investment will be made in January 2024. Chalmers will subsequently have access to these funds on a quarterly basis.

Both of these proposals were approved by the congregation at a congregational meeting on October 1st, 2023.

Lone Witness is an incredibly engaging, entertaining novel.
