Since their parents are off on a mission/holiday Lena sets out to take Chris to school for his first day. At home she is starting to prepare for the dinner, and get some housework done when there is a knock at the door. There stand two policemen with the terrible news that there has been an accident and both her parents have been killed.

Lena is absolutely devastated, and just doesn't know what to do, where to go or who to talk to. Since they are an Amish family and pastor comes to talk to her and suggests that the family will need to be split up, since no-one has the room to take in 10 children.

Chris gets settled with his grandparents and the rest of the family are taken in by various members of the church family. But it is suggested that Lena Rose should go and stay with her father's cousin, and his wife – who are happy to have her. BUT – they live a long way from Lena's home .... and her family. What to do, what to do!
